

ANNUAL REPORT

This academic session, a lot of new activities have been included as per the CBSE guidelines.

In our S.M.C meetings many suggestions have been taken regarding the learning and behavior patterns of students. Main suggestions were

1. one to one conversation with the parents to understand the behavioral patterns of students at home and make action plans accordingly. It is must to know the students first.
2. Focus should be on bridging the learning gaps along with taking the syllabus forward.

For the overall development of students and increasing their awareness for environment and country. Establishment of Eco Club is one such step. Under this club, the students have been asked to perform a lot of activities so that they can understand the importance of co-existing in the nature given to us. They were also made aware of the concept of Sustainable Development and how they can contribute in making this world a better place. Tree plantation, street plays, Slogan writing and speech are few activities among many that were conducted under the Guidance of Eco club which consists of a teacher and 40 students from classes 6th -8th.

It has been strictly implemented and monitored that classroom transactions are happening as per the NEP 2020. Especially in junior classes, the emphasis is on experiential learning and not on the traditional rote memorisation and mugging up concept. Teachers engage children in various activities and use TLM to demonstrate the concepts many times.

The overall result of class 12th and 10th has been 100% and 92.5% (2022 -23) respectively.

Students are given ample opportunities to improve their physical health, agility and fitness through different kinds of sports. Annually, an inter-house sports meet is held in winters to let students showcase their talent. Along with this we actively participate in ' Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat', ' Fit India' and other activities organised by CBSE time to time.
